Who & When?

UYC’s Summer Internship is for **current 8th-12th** graders who want to seek more from God and **begins Thurs, June 21st** (as long as it doesn’t interfere with school snow added days). There will be a week off **7/16-7/25** and the **internship ends after church on Sun, August 19th**.

What’s it looks like?

As an intern, your Christian walk and your understanding of God’s Word will grow DEEP roots over the course of 8 short weeks! You will have serving responsibilities throughout our weekly services, will become confident in your faith, will have opportunities to learn about leadership and exercise what you’ve learned, discover *why you were created*, and *build great relationships* with other interns who are on the same God-pursuit as you. There will also be plenty of class time where you will learn doctrine & discipleship. As an intern, you’ll take two trips with us to the Wave Conference in Virginia Beach and also lead middle schoolers on another trip to Headwaters, VA! (**trips’ costs included in internship cost*) ***Graduates frequently say, “I was not sure about this, BUT it was the best summer of High School!”***

Cost:

UYC Students:

The cost is only \$375/student! ***This includes all supplies + the costs for 2 trips:*** The Wave Conference in Virginia Beach (Aug 1-3) and a leadership retreat to Headwaters Camp in Virginia (July 12-15)! The **registration and a non-refundable deposit of \$200 are due by Wednesday, May 30th** while the **remaining balance of \$175 is due by Sunday, June 11th**.

Non-UYC Students:

The tuition for Summer Internship for other ministries is only \$210/student! ****All the same fees as UYC minus the leadership trip to Virginia.***

Interns Expectations:

Employment

We understand the need for money, but also don't want to live life for just money, but life for purpose, love, and deeper relationships with Christ and the people around you. If you choose to work a part-time job this summer, it is recommended that you limit your part-time work week to 20 hours or less. This will allow you to take part in many ministry opportunities that may spring up throughout the internship.

Attendance

You will have 5 days that will be excused for personal reasons or vacations. However in order to maximize your time as an intern, since the program is only 8 weeks, I recommend 3 excused absence days or less. Please let me know 3 days in advance of any doctor's appointments that are scheduled. Any emergency situations will be exceptions so that we can fill you in on stuff you don't want to miss!

The Call to Represent

Students represent much more than just themselves, but each **represents Jesus** and the church that He is building. Each student must view their life as an example to others of how to *live, act, serve, respond and love*. Therefore, these following guidelines are set in place not to be a boundary with a blessing, and to raise the standard, while maintaining the integrity of the church.

1. Warnings – If the need arises, a warning will be given and the Intern will be placed on a one-week “probation”. If there is no measurable change, plans for dismissal will be initiated.
2. Dismissal – If for any reason the warning has not resulted in measurable change, the intern will be dismissed from the program and released from any further obligations to UYC’s Intern Program. *(Due to many “early bird registration” fees your child will be registered for upon becoming an intern, refunds will not be permitted)*
